

## **Prayer for The Breaking Of Curses**

Father in the Name of Jesus, I thank you that I am your child and I have been purchased by the blood of Jesus. I thank you that you became a curse for me when you shed your precious blood at Calvary. I enter into the victory that you won for me and I take back what the devil has stolen from me in the Name of Jesus. Father, please forgive me for each of the above sins of mine and of my forefathers (naming each). I renounce them in the Name of Jesus. In the Name of Jesus, I break all curses that came upon me and my family line as a result of my disobedience or the disobedience of any of my ancestors. I renounce any oaths that my ancestors or I ever made to any false god, idol, cult, or false religion such as (naming each). I break the curse of idolatry off me and my family line in the Name of Jesus. In Jesus Name, I break the power of every spoken curse such as (name each spoken curse), or evil word that came forth from my mouth or anyone else's mouth, which has had a negative effect upon my life.

I close all those doors that have been opened to Satan and in the Name of Jesus I command every evil spirit, which has come in through the door of a curse to leave me now. Thank you Lord that whoever the Son sets free shall be free indeed. I claim my victory in the name of Jesus. Amen.

## **Generational Sin Prayers**

- 1. Recall family history. Draw up the family tree and identify those specific sins committed and possible curses. Identify re-occurring patterns of tragedies, sickness, early deaths, miscarriages, closed wombs, divorces, financial woes, etc. Leviticus 20:6 descent of harm.
- 2. In prayer, place the cross between the person and his parents, grandparents, great-grandparents. "Lord, may your blood flow back through the family bloodlines, throughout their history, by forgiveness and washing away Satan's legal ground. Jesus, destroy the re-occurring patterns of \_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_, and place it under Your blood.

(Begin to name specific individuals in the family tree.)



Lord, please forgive Uncle \_\_\_\_\_ for his sin of incest (Nehemiah 9:2) and cleanse and free the family from this curse. We renounce and break the assignment of any demonic forces sent to carry out results of this sin. I command you away from this family in Jesus name!"

Name each pattern, describing it, and calling specifically for the Lord to destroy.

"Lord, now send your angels to encamp about every member of the family (name members) (Psalm 34:2) to protect each one (Psalm 91:11,12) and to bring each one out of darkness into light (Hebrews 2:14). Lord, send forth warrior angels to do battle."

Begin to praise God for what He has done and will do.

## Specific Areas to Cover in Renouncing a Curse

- 1. Ask God to forgive the sins of ancestors. (Nehemiah 9:2)
  - A. Name each ancestral sin
  - B. Destroy these sins and sin patterns in Jesus Name
  - C. Place cross between ancestor and counselee
- 2. Counselee asks for forgiveness for their related sins.
- 3. Place any resulting curse on Jesus on the cross.
  - Jesus became a curse for us.
- 4. Command spirits out and away who would carry out their curse.
- 5. Command spirits out and away from other family members.
- 6. Close all doorways in the body, soul, and spirit.
- 7. Bring healing to each area mentioned above:
  - receive Lord's Supper, signifying the healing brought through the broken body of Christ and the shedding of His blood.



## **Our Declarations**

On the basis of Ephesians 1:7, I make the following two declarations:
