      - In what they prayed?
    - 6. What are some ways you confidence.in God's sovereignty affects your life? (family, work, group)
    - 7. Study Job's example in responding to God's sovereignty. (Job 40:1-5; 42:1-6)
    - 8. What did Jesus say about man's authority? (John 19:10-11)
