These basic ideas are presented in these passages of scripture. These are some of the acceptable answers.

Part I Who Am I As a Child of God?

1. Capacity for God and for eternal, moral and spiritual things (capacity quickened and increased if I choose to respond to the light He gives).
2. Created by God - designed by Him and uniquely fashioned for Him (not a highly developed animal...neither a glorious result of natural selection and human achievement, deserving credit; nor an unfortunate chance product of heredity and environment which is not responsible for its actions).
3. Dependent - receiving everything from God.
4. Inadequate to accomplish anything significant and enduring - or anything good in God's sight.
5. Limited in knowledge, understanding, strength, power.
6. Living in an increasingly degenerate environment.
7. Loved and sought after.
8. Member of an honored race.

11. Responsible to God - having free will, capable of purposing and acting, with the dignity of being accountable for my choices.
